4. What is this dynamic marking below, and what does it mean? * Mark only one oval.
Sfretzanda, play as loud as possible
Selfiezandi, take a photo of oneself during performance
Sforzando, a strong and sudden accent on the note
Soforteze, play without listening to your neighbor
5. What does "Same tempo (in 2)" mean? *
Mark only one oval.
Only play 2 notes per measure
Keep the same tempo, but now feel beats in 2 (half notes) rather than 4 (quarter notes)
Tempo becomes 2 times slower
Tempo becomes 2 times faster

Play in a singing style; long and connected notes


Play extremely short and accented

8. When you see two notes at one time, and the word "div." above, what do you do? * Mark only one oval.
Attempt to have one person play both notes at the same time
Sing the bottom note while playing the top note
Just play the top note, ignore the bottom note
Divide the notes so half the section plays the top note, and the other half plays the bottom
9. What does this symbol mean below? * Mark only one oval.
Long, smooth, connected
Sharp attack, accented, short
Light, delicate, floating
Fortissimo, extremely loud



10. What does "poco a poco accel." mean? * Mark only one oval.
Little by little, get faster
Do not get faster
Day by day, live on
Immediately go faster
11. What does "lightly" mean? * Mark only one oval.
Play accented, loud
Play sustained, legato
Play with a flashlight in your horn
Play staccato, not too loud
12. When you see a slur line over many notes, how do you play them? * Mark only one oval.
Tongue every note
Play really short
Tongue the first note, then smoothly connect the rest
Play the notes louder
